

# Chance to design a new school

CAUSEWAYHEAD children's art project Tot Art is asking teenagers to come up with their version of the new Wallace High School.

The school is currently being built along the road from the Tot Art HQ at Logie Kirk Hall.

Prizes for the best efforts will be donated by The Royal Academy of Engineering as part of this year's Big Draw campaign.

Tot Art's Big Draw event takes place in Logie Kirk Hall on Saturday, October 13.

Artist Wendy Briggs, who founded the project, said: "It will be an opportunity for anyone to engage with the Wallace Monument and its immediate surroundings through drawing.
